Going Deeper – Questions for Readings
Week 11

How is the Book of Deuteronomy similar to the Book of Leviticus? How is it different?

What does Moses repeatedly tell the Israelites are the most important things for them to remember when they cross the Jordan River to possess the land God has promised them? Why?

What does Moses tell the Israelites to teach their children about God? What are we called to teach our children about God today? What is similar? What is different? Why?

What are the first of God's commandments that Moses shares with the Israelites in Deuteronomy 5? Why?

What does Moses tell the Israelites to do in Deuteronomy 6:6-8? Why did Moses stress this as such an important task?

What part of the Israelites' wilderness story does Moses recount in Deuteronomy Chapter 9? Why?

What does Moses tell the Israelites God expects of them in Deuteronomy 10:12-13? How are the Israelites to live a "good life"?

What are the Israelites to pronounce from Mount Gerizim and Mount Ebal before they enter the Promised Land? Why? (Deuteronomy 11:26-32; 27:1-26)

In Chapters 12-26 of Deuteronomy, Moses reveals the specific commandments of God to the Israelites. What covenant is God making with the Israelites through these laws/commandments? What happens if they are followed? What happens if they are not?
