**Going Deeper – Questions for Readings**  
**Week 13**

**What is documented in the last half of the Book of Joshua (chapters 13-21)? Why do you think this is described in such detail? What does it tell us about God?**

**Why is there almost a civil war between the Reubenites, Gadites, and the half-tribe of Manasseh with the rest of the tribes of Israel (Joshua 22)? How is this situation resolved? What can this teach us about dealing with conflicts within the church today?**

**What does Joshua charge and commission the Israelites to do in Joshua 23-24? Why? What does he say will be the consequences if they do not follow this charge? What is the Israelites response to Joshua?**

**What happens to the Israelites after Joshua's death and the death of the leaders of his generation? Why were the Israelites not able to conquer all of the lands they had been promised by God and assigned by Joshua? (Judges 1-2)**

**Who are Othniel, Ehud, Shamgar, Deborah, and Gideon? What was their role amongst the Israelites? Why were they chosen by God? (Judges 3-7)**

**How did Gideon win the battle against the Midianites? Why did God shrink his army down to 300 men? What does this say about the power of faith? (Judges 6-7)**
