Bible Challenge 2014 Going Deeper – Questions for Readings Week 19

What does David want to do for God in 2 Samuel 7 and 1 Chronicles 17? Why? How does God respond to David's offer? Why? What does God end up doing for David instead? What does this tell us about the relationship between humanity and God?

What characteristics of God are being named by the Psalmist in Psalm 29 and 33? What is the Psalmist calling us to remember through these Psalms? Why would these Psalms have been good for King David to hear often?

When do you think David would have instructed his musicians to play and sing Psalm 20? Why?

What does the story of David and Bathsheba (2 Samuel 11-12) tell us about how God responds to and judges human sin?

How can we offer God a sacrifice of thanksgiving? (Psalm 50:14) What would that look like in our lives today?

Why are we called to praise God in Psalms 65-67? Psalms 69-70? How are these sets of Psalms different? How are they similar? What does this tell us about the richness and variety of how we can worship God? What form or style of worship is most powerful for you? Why?
