Who are Oholah and Oholibah? To what does Ezekiel compare them to in his prophecy and why? (Ezekiel 23)

What message does God have Ezekiel preach to the nation and leaders of Tyre in Ezekiel 26-28? Why?

What message does God have Ezekiel preach to the nation and leaders of Egypt in Ezekiel 29-32? Why?

What special role does God assign to Ezekiel in Ezekiel 33? What is he supposed to do? Why? What new role does God take on in Ezekiel 34? What will God be doing in this role? Why?

According to Ezekiel's prophecy, why is God going to restore Israel from its destruction? (Ezekiel 36) How is this restoration envisioned in Ezekiel 37:1-14? How do you feel after reading this vision? Why?

What does God promise to do for the Israelites in Ezekiel 37:15-28? Why is this a life-altering and life-transforming promise?

Ezekiel receives a final vision from God which he begins to describe in Ezekiel 40. What is God showing Ezekiel in this vision? Why?
