Bible Challenge 2014 Going Deeper – Questions for Readings Week 42

Why do you think Jesus tells the man who is cleansed of the unclean spirit (Mark 5:1-20) to go and tell his friends and family about everything God has done for him (Mark 5: 19) yet tells Jairus and those who witness his daughter's resurrection to tell no one about what they have seen (Mark 5:43)?

What does Jesus mean when he says, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few"? (Matthew 9:37, NRSV)

What similarities and differences do you find in the story of Jesus feeding the multitudes in all four gospels? Why do you think this is considered a miracle story? Are you inspired by this story? Why or why not? (Matthew 14:13-21, Mark 6:30-44, Luke 9:10-17, John 6:1-14)

What does Jesus mean when he says, "I am the bread of life"? (John 6:48) How does this relate to our understanding of the sacrament of Holy Communion?

According to Jesus, what is it that defiles a person or causes them to sin? Why are the Pharisees offended by this claim? (Matthew 15:10-20, Mark 7:14-23)

What is Peter's response when Jesus asks his disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" Why is his testimony about Jesus a momentous declaration? According to Matthew 16:17-19, what does Jesus promise to do for Peter after hearing his declaration? Why? Why does Jesus order his disciples not to tell anyone about who Peter declares him to be?

What is the Transfiguration? Why is it celebrated each year in the life of the church? Why do you think the Gospel of John does not include a transfiguration story? (Matthew 17:1-13, Mark 9:2-13, Luke 9:28-36)
