RESPONSIBILITIES:

Work collaboratively and coordinate with Pastor, JC Rock (contemporary worship band), and Worship Ministry Team as well as congregation members (as appropriate) on music planning and selection for worship and special events.

**Worship Music Leader maintains the right of first refusal for funerals and weddings when a pianist is requested.*

*Accompany the congregation and ensembles in worship services/settings and special events (i.e. Live Nativity, Kidz Ministry Christmas Pageant, etc.).

*Offer a variety of musical styles to enrich and enliven our spiritual and community life including traditional hymns and contemporary repertoire. Actively work to expand the musical repertoire for the enrichment of our congregation.

*Be as interested in the meaning of the music and how it contributes to our ministry as in its technical elements to add depth and emotion to the music of players and ensembles.

*Work to invite, encourage, incorporate, and arrange musical participation for our multigenerational congregation. Understand that our musical participants offer a wide range of skills, from novice to expert.

*Support our musicians in an engaging, positive way, including through fun and inspiring rehearsals.
